- Our Food area is located in Section 2. If you are planning on eating, it is best to schedule your arrival time approximately 1 to 1 1/2 hours prior to the time your group would be eating as that is when your group would arrive at our food area. Our food area is not easy to access from other sections and its best to do the sections in order.
- The House on the Rock attraction is a walking experience that encompasses many ramps, varied surfaces and outdoor areas.
 Some areas may present challenges to visitors with known heart or respiratory problems, poor circulation or difficulty walking long distances and negotiating stairs.
