



- Only service animals assisting an individual with a disability as defined by ADA are allowed. Comfort, therapy or emotional support animals do not meet the definition of service animals and are not permitted. Guests who use service animals must retain control of their animals at all times and should keep them on a leash or harness while visiting. Service animals may not be in strollers, backpacks or carriers.
- No pets are allowed. Please do not leave your pet in your car. Consider pet daycare available in Dodgeville and Spring Green.
- Outside food, alcohol and non-sealable, non-bottled beverages are not allowed after admittance and may not be consumed anywhere inside of the complex or outside areas including food and seating areas. There are outside picnic tables near the oversized vehicle parking lot if you choose to bring your own food.

HOUSE ROCK A dream turned into an ever evolving reality!

The 60-foot sandstone pinnacle known as Deer Shelter Rock had already seen many thousands of seasons come and go before it first greeted The House on the Rock creator Alex Jordan in the early 1940s. On that occasion, Mr. Jordan was merely looking for a pleasant picnic spot. Instead, high above the floor of a dramatic valley, he found his destiny.



One of the first rooms Jordan built was the Winter Room. This small space was not only a refuge from the elements but a cozy and intimate space for work and entertaining. After establishing this foothold on his favorite place, Jordan would tell you that "one thing just sort of led to another."



Despite having misgivings about losing his privacy, Alex Jordan officially opened The House on the Rock to the public in 1960. "Word got out that there was something to see out here, and people began coming around.

They'd holler up, 'Can we see your place!' I thought, by golly, I'm going to charge 50 cents a piece! And you know, they paid gladly. The first day we opened...we made \$15."

Though he may have been reluctant about sharing his pet project with the world, the public interest provided Jordan the wherewithal and encouragement to become the architect of his own dream. The phrase "less is more" was never a part of Alex's vocabulary.

Once his work on the House was completed, Alex turned his attention to creating an attraction that would impress and amaze all who saw it.
